Dear Families

As from Monday, the wearing of face coverings is compulsory in school for all staff and pupils. We are following the new guidance issued by the government last Wednesday.

Face coverings will generally not be used in lessons, although a member of staff can request one is worn. Face coverings will be compulsory on transport, on entering the school, in all corridors and in the hall and dining room.

Please ensure your child has a clean, useable face covering every day. When they are not being used, pupils will be provided with a small plastic bag to store them.

Obviously, all staff will provide all the necessary help to ensure this is all a simple process for every pupil. Staff also have the right to dispose of unsuitable face coverings. Spare, disposable masks are available in school and can be provided where necessary.

If you have reason to request that your child does not wear a mask, you must provide medical evidence. Please contact school to provide evidence or if you have any further questions or comments.

At the moment, these new rules will stay in place until further guidance is issued.
