Information for Parents:

How to support your child with their Maths work at home.

Week beginning 4 January 2021

Key Stage 3

The topic this week is <u>fractions</u>. Pupils are asked to shade a fraction of a shape or find the fraction of a quantity. They may be asked to find a half of 12 which is 6. They may be asked to find a quarter of 12 which is 3. They can put things into groups or just use division (sharing).

Objectives : To recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

To recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

To be able to use the concept and language of quarter / quarters in practical situations eg. can group 12 counters into four equal groups

To be able to work out 1/2 of 8 = 4 and 1/3 of 6 = 2 using images as appropriate.

Work has been set on <u>MyMaths</u> or a paper version has been sent to those that have requested it. Pupils are asked to do <u>the lesson tasks first</u> before attempting the <u>Homework</u> <u>on MyMaths</u>. Pupils may use <u>Numeracy Warm Up</u> or <u>Numeracy Workout</u> to help them (Username: pebblebrook Password: width86).

Once work has been completed pupils can submit it and can get a score, which their teachers can monitor.

Key Stage 4

Pupils are doing different topics depending on the courses they are following. Their maths teachers will set them work.

Pupil work has been set on <u>MyMaths</u> or a paper version has been sent to those that have requested it. Pupils are asked to do the lesson tasks first before attempting the <u>Homework</u> <u>on MyMaths</u>. Pupils may use <u>Numeracy Warm Up or Numeracy Workout</u> to help them (Username: pebblebrook Password: width86).

Once work has been completed pupils can submit it and can get a score.
