
**The Parents/Carers of Pupils attending Pebble Brook

- ❖ see that my/our child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped
- ❖ see that my/our child goes to bed at a sensible time
- ❖ let the school know by 9.30 a.m. why my/our child is absent
- ❖ tell the school about any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's behaviour
- ❖ support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- ❖ Understand that the staff and Behaviour Support Team will help my/our child to manage their behaviour in school through a Behaviour Support Plan if needed
- ❖ Understand that if my/our child's behaviour places themselves or others at risk of harm that trained staff will use approved Team Teach techniques to maintain safety within the school
- ❖ encourage my/our child to take advantage of opportunities to learn, including homework
- ❖ attend parents' evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress
