<p>General Statement of Intent:</p> <p>Pupils in Y9/ KS4 &amp;5 have the opportunity to experience woodwork at Queens Park Arts Centre. Pupils that have expressed an interest in working practically and or working in the building trade have weekly sessions in a small group (8) to develop their skills.</p>	
<p>Knowledge and Skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pupils develop their listening skills, following instructions both verbally and written.</li><li>• Pupils are encouraged to ask questions to help them work independently</li><li>• Pupils are shown how to use tools correctly and safely ( e.g hand saw, chisel, hammer. lathe, mallet etc) gaining an increasing understanding of Health and Safety guidelines.</li><li>• Pupils develop their confidence by completing a task and creating 'something from nothing ' with a final product either a table or 'music' box</li><li>• Pupils will get a sense of achievement and success in a non-academic subject in a highly supported environment.</li></ul>
